City lift stations are designed to operate with two grinder pumps. Per our inspection we found that there is only one grinder pump working at each lift station. Staff has asked pass administration for replacements to no avail. This could be a BIG FDEP FINE. The city recently had two lift stations go down and we had to rent a bypass pump for one month until the new grinder pump came in. Renting a bypass pump costs \$3,000 per month. Grinders average 2-4 weeks for delivery. Each grinder pump costs \$21,000. If the City has raw sewer overflow, we must report it to the FDEP and there will be fines plus clean up cost.

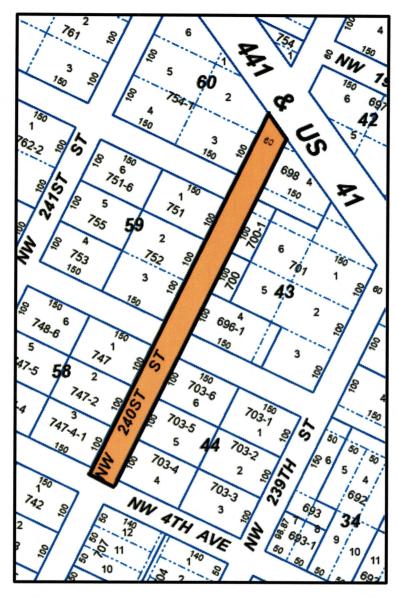

FIGURE 3: NW 176 AVE



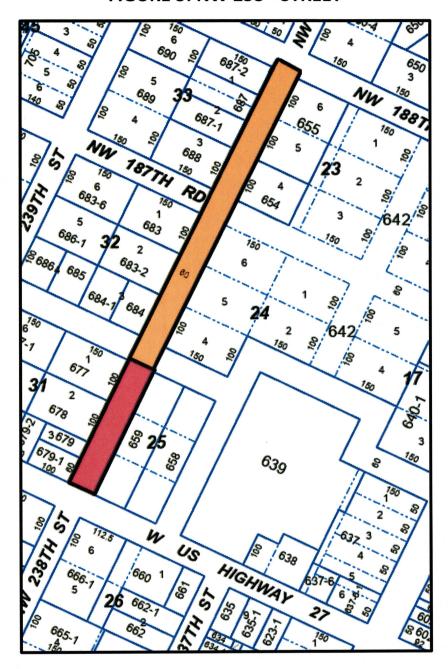

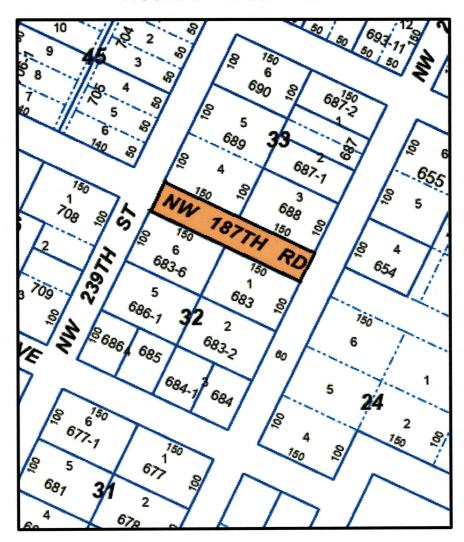
FIGURE 5: NW 238th STREET

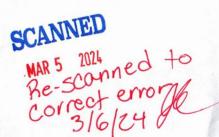

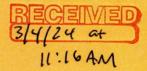

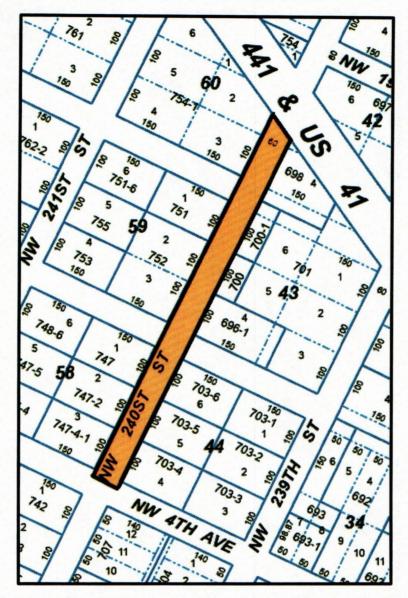

FIGURE 3: NW 176 AVE



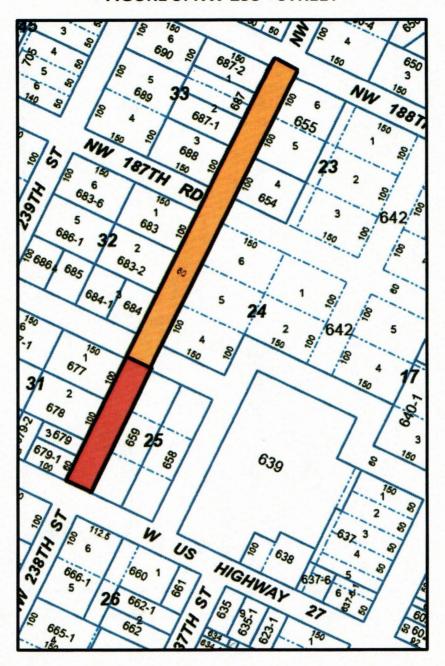

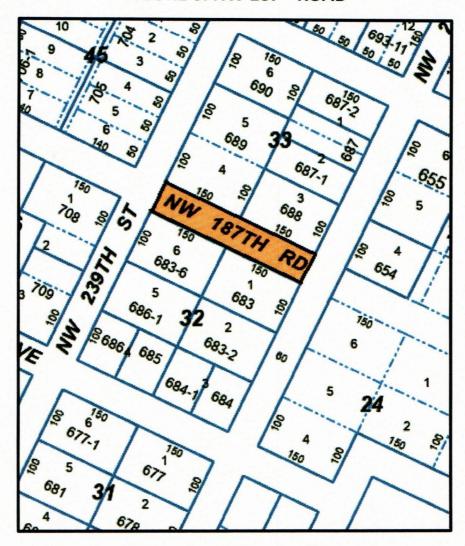
FIGURE 5: NW 238th STREET

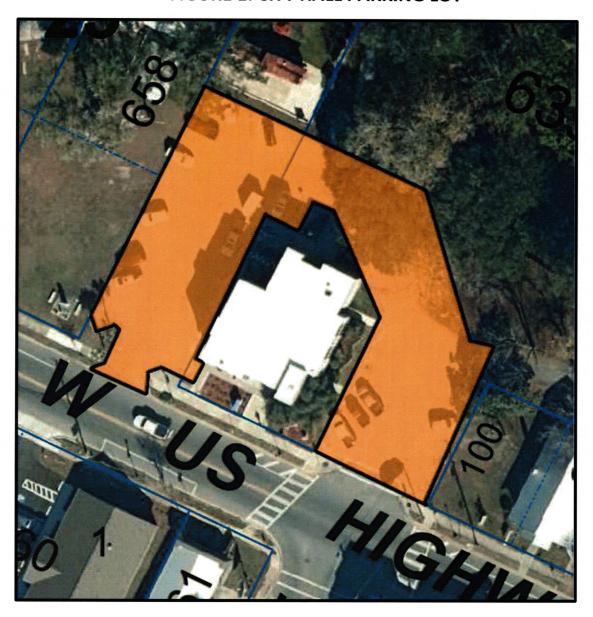
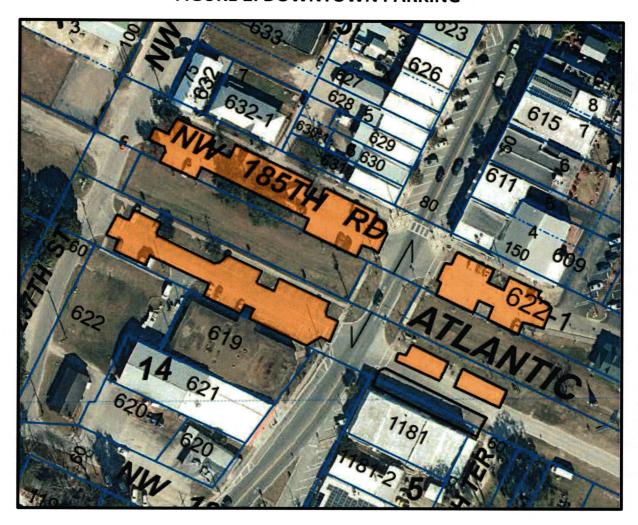


FIGURE 2: DOWNTOWN PARKING

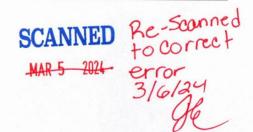

Volume I - Technical

The purpose of this solicitation is to provide repavement services.

The scope of work includes cleaning of existing asphalt paving surfaces, crack sealing of existing cracks, prime oil/fuel areas, place two coats of high-quality asphalt sealer, apply white/yellow/blue traffic marking paints, to include pavement striping and handicap parking spaces.

Subfactor 1 Qualifications

For the duration of this project ABH intends to have a project superintendent, and in-house staff to perform the required work. In addition, ABH has an office manager that will be involved as required. The project superintendent has good communication and organizational skills, experience dealing with clients, and can resolve conflict as required. We are a small company, and highly experienced in general contracting (residential and commercial work), including asphalt sealing and pavement marking. It is our intent to provide the necessary resources to complete this project in a productive and efficient manner.

We are pleased to provide our proposal for all materials, labor, and supervision, as required for this project. Our proposal is based on a meeting at the site with Hunter Lindsey, and the Request For Proposals/Bids For: "RFP-2024-02- Parking Lot Repavement", and site visit/inspections.

The work consists of repavement services at the five locations. The materials to be used on this project are manufactured and supplied by Gemseal Pavement Products; a well-known, respected, and reputable company, with a long history in this industry.

The work this proposal covers includes:

- Clean the existing asphalt surface of all loose dust, dirt, leaves, and all foreign materials
 by sweeping, blowing, flushing with water, or any combination of the three.
- Remove oil and grease spots scrubbing with a detergent and flushing with water. Deeper
 penetration will be treated by burning with a hand-held torch, then coating the spots with
 a primer (Gemseal TarPrime).
- Prime high oxidized or weathered asphalt, as needed, using diluted Guardian AE
 Pavement Sealer (a Gemseal Asphalt Emulsion, fortified with proprietary compounds
 for added strength and durability).
- Clean cracks (1/4"-3/4") of debris and fill cracks with a Gemseal Crack Sealer (Hot Applied).
- Apply asphalt emulsion sealer (Guardian AE, two coats); the first coat will be squegee applied, and the second coat will be sprayed to get a more asthetically pleasing and uniform coverage. The application mix gal/sq. yd will be from 0.11-0.15.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of High Springs passed Ordinance 2023-03 on May 25, 2023, providing authority for golf cart operation on City streets within the City of High Springs and creating Section 74-6 of the City of High Springs Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, House Bill No. 949 amended Florida Statute 316.212 prohibiting a person under 18 years of age from operating a golf cart on certain roadways unless he or she possesses a valid learner's driver license or valid driver's license; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of High Springs to revise its Code to comply with State Statute; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF HIGH SPRINGS, FLORIDA as the following:

Section 1. Section 74-6(a) of the City of High Springs Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to be read as follows (additions are <u>underlined</u> and deletions of struck through):

(a) *Definitions*. For purposes of this section, and unless the context clearly requires otherwise, the following terms and phrases shall have meanings herein ascribed:

City means the City of High Springs.

City commission means the City Commission of the City of High Springs.

County means Alachua County.

Golf cart means a motor vehicle that is designed and manufactured for operation on a golf course for sporting or recreational purposes that is not capable of exceeding speeds of 20 miles per hour.

Operator means a person who is 15 years of age or older while operating a golf cart within the eity. who is under 18 years of age and possesses a valid learner's driver license or valid driver's license while operating a golf cart within the City or someone who is 18 years of age or older and possesses a valid form of government-issued photographic identification while operating a golf cart within the City.

Street means all of those city streets as determined by the city commission to meet the criteria of this section and applicable Florida Statutes for the use of golf carts thereon.

Section 2. The remainder of Section 74-6 and its subjections of the High Springs Code of

Section 3. Conflict. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10 "ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES" OF THE HIGH SPRINGS CODE OF ORDINANCES; LIFTING RESTRICTIONS ON ON-PREMISE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON SUNDAYS FOR BUSINESSES DERIVING LESS THAN 51 PERCENT OF THEIR REVENUE FROM THE SALE OF FOOD AND NONALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION

WHEREAS, Chapter 10 of the High Springs Code of Ordinances regulates the sale of alcoholic beverages within the City limits; and

WHEREAS, on December 16, 2008, the City Commission amended Chapter 10 in Ordinance 2008-34 to allow for the sale of alcohol during specific hours on Sunday for malt beverages and unfortified beverages at businesses that derive at least 51 percent of their gross revenue from the sale of food and nonalcoholic beverages; and

WHEREAS, on April 9, 2015, the City Commission amended Chapter 10 in Ordinance 2015-03 lifting restrictions on the type of alcohol for Sunday on-premises consumption at businesses that derive at least 51 percent of their gross revenue from the sale of food and nonalcoholic beverages; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has determined that removing regulatory barriers to business, such as restrictions on the sale of alcoholic beverages on Sundays by businesses that derives less than 51 percent of their gross revenue from the sale of food or nonalcoholic beverages will encourage growth and development of the City, enhance economic prosperity, diversity, and opportunity; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of High Springs has determined that it is desirable to amend Section 10-2 (d) of the High Springs Code of Ordinances to lifting restrictions on, on-premise consumption of alcoholic beverages to allow alcohol to be sold on Sundays for all businesses with alcoholic beverage licenses;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HIGH SPRINGS:

Section 1: Section 10-2 of the High Springs Code of Ordinances entitled "Hours of Sale" is hereby amended to read as follows (words **struck through** have been deleted, and words **underlined** have been added):

(c) Sales for on-premises consumption of alcoholic beverages in any business holding a beverage license, which business derives at least 51 percent of its gross revenue from the sale of food and nonalcoholic beverages, shall be permitted on Monday through

Thursday, inclusive, and Saturday between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 12:00 midnight, on Friday between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m. immediately following, and Sunday between the hours of 1:00 pm. and 11:00 p.m. When December 31 occurs on a Saturday through Thursday, sales of all alcoholic beverages on those days shall be permitted to continue until 2:00 a.m. immediately following.

- (d) Sales for on-premises consumption of alcoholic beverages in any business holding a beverage license, which business derives less than 51 percent of its gross revenue from the sale of food and nonalcoholic beverages, shall be permitted on Monday through Thursday, inclusive, and Saturday, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 12:00 midnight, and on Friday between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m. immediately following. When December 31 occurs on a Monday through Thursday or Saturday, such sales of alcoholic beverages on those days shall be permitted to continue until 2:00 a.m. immediately following. When December 31 occurs on a Sunday, such sales of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted from 6:00 p.m. of the Sunday until 2:00 a.m. immediately following.
- <u>Section 2</u>. Severability. If any provision or portion of this ordinance is declared by any court of competent jurisdiction to be void, unconstitutional or unenforceable, then all remaining provisions and portions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
- <u>Section 3</u>. Conflict. All ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- <u>Section 4</u>. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage at second and final reading.
- <u>Section 5.</u> Codifier. All text shown in **bold and strike through** is to be deleted. All text shown in **bold and underline** is adopted.
