- d) Signs using light other than illuminated signs specifically permitted in Section 23.09, 2003 Land Development Code;
- e) Signs that emit noise, odor, smoke or steam;
- f) Portable signs;
- g) Snipe signs unless otherwise permitted in this Land Development Code;
- h) Signs displaying copy harmful to minors;
- i) Signs which obstruct or impair vision of motorists, cyclists, or pedestrians, or which interfere with entrances, exits or safety equipment;
- j) Signs that project beyond the parapet of a roof line, or above the horizontal line of a flat roof;
- k) Banner except as permitted in Section 23.06, 2003 Land Development Code.
